- Ages 0-3 years: During the worship services, a nursery is provided for infants and toddlers on the north side of the building and is staffed by adult volunteers from our congregation. The service is broadcast in the pastor's study for nursing moms. The service is also broadcast in the conference room (across from the restrooms) during the service if parents need a quiet space to sit or talk with their children.
- Ages 2 years old–12th Grade: Sunday school classes are offered for all grade levels at 9:30AM, January through April and September through November.
- Grades 6-12: Middle School Youth Group meets the 1st Sunday of the month 7-8:30PM and High School Youth Group meets the 3rd Sunday of the month, 7-9PM at Upward Bound Ministries, 541 E Washington, Zeeland, October through April. A meal is provided.
